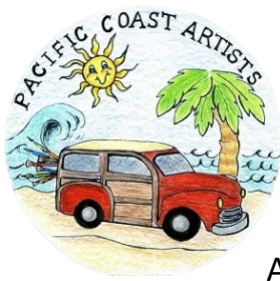

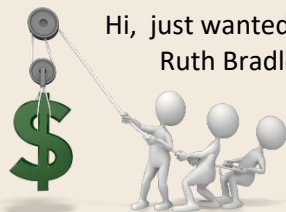

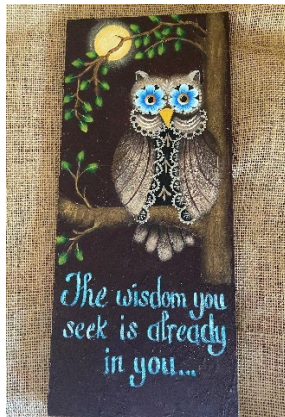

Program Notes ...

We have Tami Carmody coming up in January. She will be teaching us how to paint on glass. If you have never taken a class from Tami this is your opportunity. Tami will be providing the Folk Art Enamel paints; you provide the surface and bring your softest brushes. This project is painted on a floating frame from Michaels. It's the Studio Décor brand. SKU# 507327 8 x 10. Or you can paint the design on any glass or metal surface of your choice.

Please support Pacific Coast Artists in bringing you teachers like Tami, she will be traveling a long way and it would be great to have a full class.

February, we have another teacher who travels a long distance, Janet Mitchell, she will be teaching a Rosemary West design on a rough textured surface. She can provide the surface for \$8.00, please let me know right away if you are interested in the surface. If you have never painted a Rosemary West design there is a lot of dry brushing to achieve the see-through look, allowing the black background to peek through. Janet is a great teacher so please sign up right away. Paints will not be provided. We will be using Decoart Americana paint.

March is Fran Wilson teaching an Erica Joanne design. Erica's designs are copyrighted and require you to purchase the electronic version of the pattern. Fran was able to get a discount, so we are passing it on to you. When you sign up for the class, include a check for the pattern made out to Fran Wilson for \$5.85, discounted from \$8.95. This is a fun design using Decoart Americana paint and Prisma Colored pencils. There are elements of buttons and strings in the design. Go through your stash of buttons and see what interesting ones you can find to add to your pumpkin. Fran has the twine, or you can bring your own. Bring your own paints and pencils. The surface is available at Hobby Lobby SKU# 1441088 for \$10.99.

OC FAIR

July 14 - Aug 13, 2023

The OC Fair has announced that "Happy Together" will be the theme of the 2023 event that will run July 14 -August 13, highlighting community inclusion. Here's what to know:

When: July 14-Aug. 13, open Wednesday through Sunday. The new hours are 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday; and 11 a.m. to midnight Friday and Saturday.

Ticket info: Advance ticket purchase will again be required with limited capacity. Admission tickets will go on sale online in early 2023 and will be restricted to 45,000 admissions available per day. OC Fair will again absorb the online admission ticket transaction fees. Admission tickets will not be available for sale at OC Fair entry gates.

Ticket prices: There will be a slight increase in general admission ticket prices for the first time since 2014 to \$13 general admission on weekdays (Wednesday, Thursday) and \$15 on weekends (Friday, Saturday and Sunday). Tickets for seniors 60+ and kids 6-13 are \$9 all days.

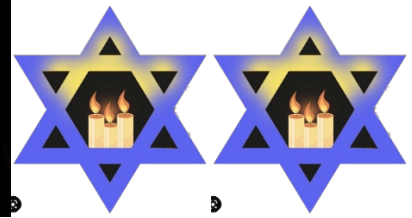
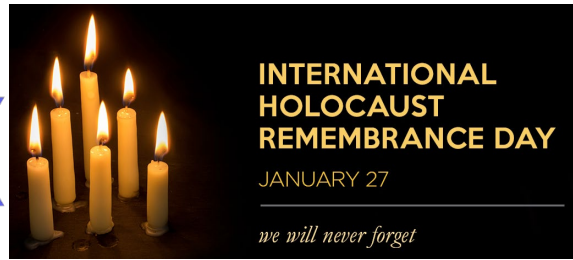

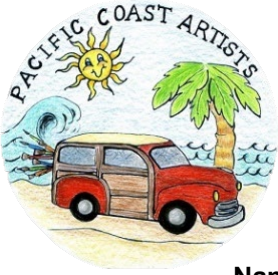
April 15, 2023
