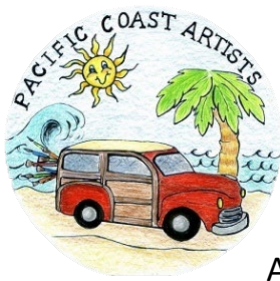

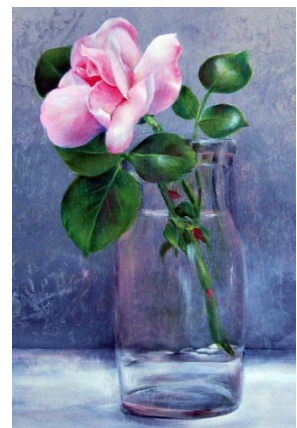

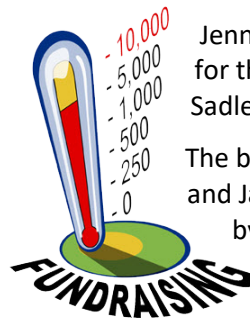
Welcome returning member Sandy Lonnecker.

Mystery Paint-In

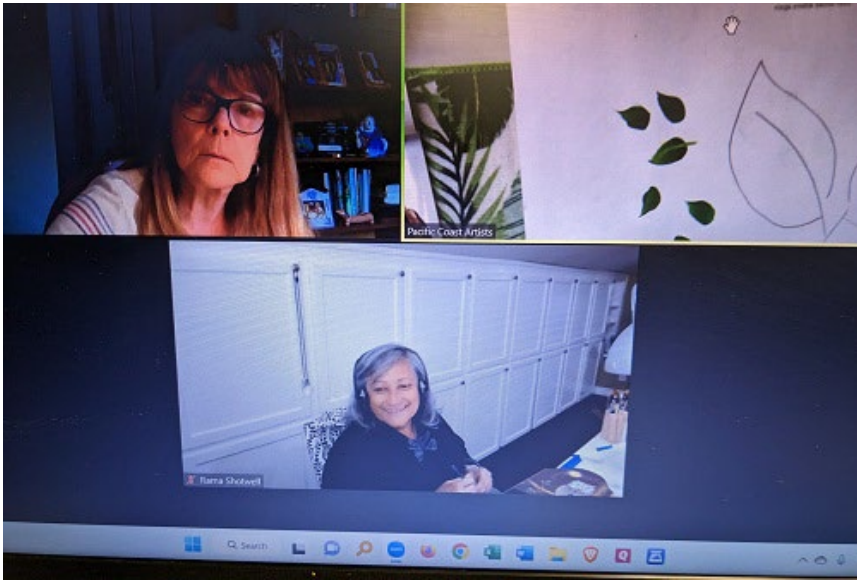

PACIFIC COAST ARTISTS – General Meeting, Saturday, February 18, 2023

Attendees: Linda Martin, Onya Tolmasoff, Rama Shotwell, Pat Salios, Katy Taylor, Robyn McComb, Esther Carrion, Regina Taylor, June O’Connell, Jennie Pascual, Fran Wilson (joined at 10:01 am), Maureen Kleinman

President Linda Martin called the meeting to order at 9:52 am. Reported on the last PCA Board meeting (Jan. 17, 2023). The Board will meet monthly on the 2nd Tuesday of each month to speak more and be more cohesive as a Board. Also, General Meetings dates will be posted on the PCA website.

Linda reported that the Bylaws are currently being changed because PCA is no longer a “chapter”. When finalized, the new Bylaws will be posted on the PCA website and emailed to each member for their files.

Linda reported that current open positions are Programs, Fundraising and Corresponding Secy. Esther Carrion volunteer to be Corresponding Secretary. Linda will need a nominating committee for 2024 for the above positions as well as President when her term is up.

Treasurer: Onya reported the checking acct balance as of this date is \$5,556.78. The Audit, done by Laurinda Rick and Lorna Parong, has been completed and all figures balanced. The IRS website is still under construction so Onya still has to complete PCA paperwork. Has until May 15 to get the 990N done.

The Budget was published in the Feb. Newsletter and no comments were received so a motion was made by Esther to approve it as published in the Feb. Newsletter and Jennie seconded it. The vote was unanimous.

Programs: Linda gave an update.

March: Mixed Media project taught by Fran Wilson. There are still openings; \$5.85 pattern fee payable to Fran Wilson.

April: “Pink Rose” Zoom-only Seminar taught by Maureen J. Baker. Linda has started receiving sign-ups.

Linda has received teacher submission for programs beginning in May through March 2024. Members will be able to vote at the March paint-in.

Membership: Jennie reported we have 25 members. Reminder to wear your badge at paint-ins.

MPI: Katy reported that the teacher & project are confirmed for Oct. 21. It will be “something really different”. The price is TBD b/c Katy needs more info and details before she can set the price.

OC Fair: Linda sent an email to all PCA members with information. Also the “make it & take it” opportunity will resume this year.

Corresp Secy: Esther Carrion volunteered for this position to replace Diane Hendricks.

Fundraising: June will be collecting items for Easter at the March paint-in. Donations can be baskets, individual items or money.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:05am.
